## News/Progress

### ComProCom will be completed in August 2017



ComProCom aimed at the development of concise descriptions of competence for complicated, higher-level occupations. The project stems from international interest in what might be called a 'second-generation' approach to describing competence. This approach is concise but holistic and appears to be highly robust as well as being able to accommodate the evolution of practice without frequent revision.

The project is to be completed in August 2017. Its actions and its results are posted on its website.

## Meetings/Events

### European Conference on Development of Professional Competence Frameworks, 13 of June 2017, Athens

The final Conference of ComProCom addressed current trends in the area of competence description, and in that context, the main outputs of the transnational cooperation among partners from Austria, Germany, Greece, Ireland, United Kingdom and Poland be presented and discussed.



The main outputs consist of the ComProCom methodological manual, developer course, and five competence frameworks in the fields of the management of social cooperative enterprises, research and innovation, professional training and development, chemical engineering and management of startup enterprises.

## Experiential Workshop

EETAA organized an experiential workshop titled Development of Professional Competence Frameworks on 14th of June 2017, in Athens.

This workshop aimed at assisting the participants in applying the ComProCom Framework and principles in a bounded microcosmic manner. Working with the ComProCom Methodological Guide participants be engaged in a 'walk through and do' session from which they will gain insight and skill in applying the ComProCom Framework in their own specific professional contexts following the Athens event. The closing aspect of this session was a Questions and Answers session where participant raised questions regarding the ComProCom Framework and its application.
